Confirmation of Newspaper Advertisement

Within ten working days starting on the day after you make your application a notice advertising the application must be published in a local newspaper which circulates in the locality.

The advertisement must include the following information:

- The name of the applicant or club
- The postal address of the premises (or if none a description to identify the location)
- The date by which representations must be made

The following 3 statements:

- 1. "Interested parties or responsible authorities wishing to oppose the application must give notice in writing to: The London Borough of Redbridge, Licensing Service, 10th Floor, Lynton House, 255-259 High Road, Ilford Essex IG1 1NN"
- 2. "IT IS AN OFFENCE, LIABLE ON CONVICTION TO A FINE UP TO LEVEL 5 ON THE STANDARD SCALE [£5000], UNDER SECTION 158 OF THE LICENSING ACT 2003 TO MAKE A FALSE STATEMENT IN OR IN CONNECTION WITH THIS APPLICATION"
- 3. "The record of this application may be inspected Monday to Friday (except Bank Holidays) at the offices of The London Borough of Redbridge, Licensing Service, 10th Floor, Lynton House, 255-259 High Road, Ilford Essex IG1 1NN between the hours of 10.00 a.m. to noon and 2.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m. or on the Redbridge website at: https://www.redbridge.gov.uk/business-and-regeneration/licensing-including-street-trading/alcohol-and-entertainment-licences/"

When the notice has appeared in the newspaper a copy of the relevant page must be sent to the Licensing Authority together with this completed form
