Reason for removal	Originally planted as a trial of a new species. Now considered to be an inappropriate species due to habit and shape.
Solutions considered	Pruning is not considered a suitable solution, due to the tree's speed of growth and it is not considered appropriate for the landscape
Replacement	A single replacement tree, suitable for this position, is programmed to be planted between November 2024 and March 2025
