The period of consultation has ended. This is a notification that this tree is proposed to be removed 28 days from the date of this notice. This decision notice meets the duty to consult and notify when removing street trees set out in section 115 of the Environment Act 2021

Summary of responses	There was a single response to the consultation. The response did not object to the tree's removal, as it was a request to clarify the reason for removal and why a notice had been attached. The consultee was provided further detail about the Environment Act and the reason for removal.
Decision summary	Work to fell the tree and then plant a replacement tree in the winter will proceed.

Reason for removal	Sufficient evidence has been provided to implicate the tree in a subsidence claim to neighbouring properties
Solutions considered	Pruning is not considered a suitable solution, due to the tree's ultimate size, speed of growth and it is not considered appropriate for the landscape
Replacement	A single replacement tree, suitable for this position, is programmed to be planted between November 2024 and March 2025
