Reason for removal	There is a utility upgrade, which requires the excavation of a "T" junction gas main where the tree is located. Alternative methods to upgrade the gas main will be investigated during the consultation process; however, if these are not successful it may be necessary to remove the tree so that the gas main may be upgraded.
Solutions considered	Alternative methods to upgrade the gas main will be investigated during the consultation process and if successful the tree will be retained.
Replacement	If the tree is removed a single replacement tree, suitable for this position, is programmed to be planted between November 2024 and March 2025.
