Reason for removal Due to the trees habit and shape we are unable to create a suitable pollard structure to maintain the tree in future.

Solutions considered Pruning is not considered a suitable solution, due to the tree's habit, speed of growth and it is not considered appropriate for the landscape

Replacement A single replacement tree, suitable for this position, is programmed to be planted between November 2024 and March 2025
