Species Prunus serrula 'Tibetica' (Tibetan Cherry)

Reason for removal Due to growth habit and shape, due to historical limb loss and low vigour the tree is unable to be maintained to form a suitable crown for a Highway maintained tree

Solutions considered Pruning is not considered a suitable solution, due to the tree's ultimate size, speed of growth. The pruning required to remove obstructions from the Highway will be excessive leaving very few branches.

Replacement A single replacement tree, suitable for this position, is programmed to be planted between November 2024 and March 2025
