## Duty to Consult on Felling Street Trees

This is a notification that this tree is proposed to be removed. From the date of this notice there is a 28 day period in which you can provide comments on the proposed tree removal. This notice meets the duty to consult requirements set out in section 115 of the Environment Act 2021

<b>Ward</b>	Valentines
<b>Site</b>	Lynton Crescent
<b>Position</b>	Side of 536 Eastern Avenue Third from junction, Near 32
<b>Species</b>	Pyrus calleryana 'Chanticleer' (Callery Pear)
<b>Reason for removal</b>	Sufficient evidence has been provided to implicate the tree in a subsidence claim to neighbouring properties

**Solutions considered** Pruning is not considered a suitable solution, due to the tree's ultimate size, speed of growth and it is not considered appropriate for the landscape

**Replacement** A single replacement tree, suitable for this position, is programmed to be planted between November 2025 and March 2026
